Dear Mr. Brazier:

This letter is to all EPA Hydronic Heaters Program partners who have qualified Phase 2 hydronic heaters for which testing was conducted using EPA Method 28 OWHH (as opposed to the revised method, EPA Method 28 WHH; see <http://www.epa.gov/burnwise/testmethods.html> for further information).

Please be advised that as of June 14, 2013, you should remove efficiency information for all EPA qualified models that were tested using Method 28 OWHH from websites and all printed materials including manuals that advertise these models as being EPA qualified. Please notify retailers to discontinue use of the existing hangtags and printed materials and to remove existing hangtags and printed materials from any of these models. You may replace the old hangtags with the enclosed new hangtags for the following models.

- E-Classic 1400
- E-Classic 2300
- E-Classic 2400
- E-Classic 3200
- Maxim M250

Note that the enclosed hangtags no longer include efficiency, emissions for maximum test run, emissions based on input values, and emissions per 10,000 BTU output. We have added maximum output rating. You may continue to provide efficiency information on hangtags, websites, etc. for qualified models for which testing was conducted using the revised method, EPA Method 28 WHH. You may choose to retest a previously qualified model with the revised EPA Method 28 WHH.
