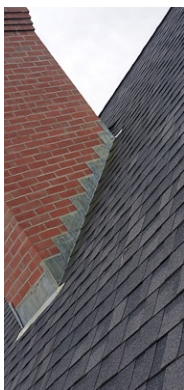

Comments/Findings

Issue noted if any

- The crown is starting to deteriorate, this will potentially allow water to penetrate and deteriorate the chimney from the inside.



Recommendations

- Grind the surface of the cement crown smooth and apply crowncoat.
- Install a full coverage cap to protect the chimney.
- Apply waterproofing to extend the life of the chimney.
