Manufacturer's Comment

Rarely does one find economy and practicality combined as beautifully as in the Vigilant. Its design was inspired by its larger brother, the Defiant, and by the architectural heritage of late 19th Century America. The delicate moldings and reliefs recall the graceful public buildings of that era, many of which still surround the picturesque village greens here in Vermont. The quality of the castings and the refinement of design will enhance the decor of any home. The Vigilant reaffirms our belief that a parlor stove can be a pleasing piece of furniture, as it was generations ago, and not just an ugly alternative to the high prices of fuel.

The Vigilant is available as a woodburner with optional glass panels, or as a highly efficient coal-burner, already equipped with glass doors, which will easily convert to wood.

Like the Defiant and Resolute, the Vigilant can be used as an open fire-place or an airtight heating unit. The same high-quality castings and automatic thermostatic control will assure you and your family of even, radiant heat for hours on a single loading. To

maintain the highly efficient combustion of the Defiant in this smaller stove, the Vigilant has three separate air systems that distribute preheated oxygen to the critical parts of the fire.

A popular feature of the Vigilant is smokeless top loading. The large, polished cooking griddle raises easily, allowing wood to be dropped directly into the firebox while the specially designed smoke chamber prevents any smoke from escaping into the room. The hidden griddle hinges provide an uninterrupted cooking surface which you can easily lift out for cleaning. An elegant cast iron warming shelf which increases the stovetop area is available as a Vigilant accessory. Like many of the old wood cookstoves that are still common in Vermont farmhouses, the Vigilant comes equipped with two folding drying racks that tuck out of sight when not in use.

And for ease and flexibility of installation, the Vigilant's flue collar is reversible to permit either top or rear exit mode.
